

MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Seat entitlement is personal to the Member or his/her nominee.
2. Auckland Rugby Membership entitles one person only (being the Member or his/her nominee) entry to Eden Park at any one time. The Members or their nominee shall produce and hand over their Membership Card or relevant tickets when asked by an Eden Park usher or security staff member.
3. Auckland Rugby Members are requested to advise Eden Park ushers or security staff of any unauthorised person(s) sitting in their allocated seat(s) for designated fixtures.
4. a) Right of admission to Eden Park is subject to regulations relating to venue. Auckland Rugby Members are not permitted to bring the following items into the stadium: glass bottles, metal containers, cans, alcohol or any other offensive items. b) Video or movie camera and other recording devices may be prohibited.
5. Where non-smoking areas are specified, Members must comply with these conditions.
6. Auckland Rugby Football Union reserves the right to on-sell membership seats for additional fixtures (such as semi-finals/finals) in the event that the membership seat has not been ordered or paid for by the deadline specified on the order form.
7. The Auckland Rugby Member(s) named on the Membership Card is responsible for the Membership Card(s) at all times. It is the Member's responsibility to ensure that any other person using the card(s) is aware of the responsibilities and limitations of the membership and complies with these Terms and Conditions where relevant.
8. Auckland Rugby Membership is for a 12 month period from 1 November 2006 to 31 October 2007.
9. Auckland Rugby Football Union reserves the right not to renew any individual's membership at the sole discretion of the Auckland Rugby Football Union and/or to discontinue the membership at any point in the future. If a Member fails to renew their membership by the date specified, all rights to membership will cease forthwith.
10. Allocation of seats is at the sole discretion of the Auckland Rugby Football Union.
11. Members or their nominees must vacate Eden Park when requested to do so by staff working on behalf of the Eden Park Trust Board.
12. Membership Cards remain the property of the Auckland Rugby Football Union and the Member is not permitted to sell their rights or the use of the card to a third party. Members must return their Membership Card to the Auckland Rugby Football Union in the event that membership is cancelled or forfeited.
13. Auckland Rugby Football Union reserves the right to assign Members with new seats to accommodate the ongoing development of Eden Park.
14. Breach or misuse of these conditions will, at the discretion of the Auckland Rugby Football Union, result in cancellation or forfeiture of the rights of membership. The Union has the right to forfeit your membership in the event of, but not limited to the following circumstances:
 - a) outstanding monies owed for membership or other designated fixtures (e.g. semi-final/finals games);
 - b) the breach of any of the Eden Park bylaws by the Member or his/her nominee. (Bylaws notices are available on request and are displayed at entrances to Eden Park);
 - c) any breach of these Terms and Conditions.
15. Membership Cards that are lost or stolen must be reported to the Auckland Rugby Football Union Customer Services. There will be a replacement fee of \$20.00 per card.
16. If any current Member does not wish to continue to be a Member on the Terms and Conditions outlined above they must advise the Auckland Rugby Football Union in writing that they wish to cancel the membership and return the Membership Card to the Eden Park Trust Board within 30 days of the date on which these Terms and Conditions were posted. In the event that membership is cancelled pursuant to this clause any fees paid by the Member for the 2007 year shall be refunded in full to that Member.
17. Personal information is gathered and stored in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993 to identify the purchaser and allow the Auckland Rugby Football Union to advise the purchaser of upcoming events.
18. Members agree that it is an essential condition of issuance of Membership Cards and/or Match Tickets and the right of admission to the Matches conferred on the Member that Cards/Tickets will not be: a) offered, provided, resold or transferred at a premium; b) used in relation to any commercial purposes (including any competitions, advertising, promotion or as a prize in any competition or sweepstake) or to enhance the demand for any other goods or services or as part of a hospitality or travel package; and/or c) bundled with any other goods or services (including as part of any hospitality or travel package), without Auckland Rugby's prior written consent.
